At the last CMT Partnership meeting, we agreed that we would lead on developing a joint approach to celebrating diversity and social cohesion in the borough. A lot of work has taken place over the last eight or so weeks, and the outcome of this is the *Together we are Barnet* campaign that we are aiming to launch at the end of May.

- 1) Together we are Barnet artwork as outlined above.
- 2) Musical performance by One Voice Choir (local Barnet school children) singing a song about unity. We are currently exploring appetite and opportunities for performance.
- Development of a World Food Market celebrating the range of cuisine that reflects the diverse cultural influences in the borough that will be hosted in Southern Square initially.
- 4) Winter religious events and festivals. We are currently scoping a piece of work about how we can work with faith organisations to open their doors to a wider group to share experiences, and understanding.
- 5) Commission of a Children and Young People photography project. To reflect the commitment to consider children and young people when addressing priorities, we want to engage children and young people in a photography project, where they submit images that

represent their vision of life in Barnet and what community means to them. We hope to take a selection of the photographs on a touring exhibition around the borough. We will be bidding to the Home Office's Building a Stronger Britain Together programme for funding and support from M&C Saatchi to run this project, and we'll keep you updated on the progress of this.

Funding

With regards to funding, we are very grateful for those who have offered to support this work with a £1,000 contribution. Will or I will be getting in touch individually over the next week to organise payments.

This will be a way of driving submissions for residents to take part in the campaign, including the artwork outlined above.

Campaign in a Box

We will be working with partners to increase visibility of the campaign across the borough, and reach a much wider audience. We will be providing them with campaign materials to put out through their own channels.

Community Projects

As a reminder there is a summary below of the projects we are proposing to run.

- 11) Together we are Barnet artwork as outlined above.
- 12) Musical performance by One Voice Choir (local Barnet school children) singing a song about unity. We are currently exploring appetite and opportunities for performance.
- 13) Development of a World Food Market celebrating the range of cuisine that reflects the diverse cultural influences in the borough that will be hosted in Southern Square initially.
- 14) Winter religious events and festivals. We are currently scoping a piece of work about how we can work with faith organisations to open their doors to a wider group to share experiences, and understanding. This is in response to council motion at the end of last year.
- 15) Commission of a Children and Young People photography project. To reflect the commitment to consider children and young people when addressing priorities, we want to engage children and young people in a photography project, where they submit images that represent their vision of life in Barnet and what community means to them. We hope to take a selection of the photographs on a touring exhibition around the borough. We will be bidding to the Home Office's Building a Stronger Britain Together programme for funding and support from M&C Saatchi to run this project, and we'll keep you updated on the progress of this.
