I am writing to advise you that we have received a complaint concerning loud music noise allegedly emanating from your premises.

We have not witnessed a statutory noise nuisance but I feel it is important to inform you of the situation now. You should consider whether there are any grounds for a complaint and, more importantly, see whether you can take action yourself to prevent disturbances to those around you.

We will now be carrying out an investigation to determine whether the alleged noise is causing a statutory nuisance. If the noise is found to be causing a statutory nuisance, the Council is obliged to serve a formal noise abatement notice under the above mentioned legislation. Any noise witnessed by an officer that is considered to be a statutory nuisance after the service of such a notice is an offence, for which noise making equipment can be seized and/or the person responsible for the noise nuisance may be prosecuted.

It is hoped that formal action will not be necessary if you now take steps to prevent further instances of noise nuisance.

If you feel that you are not responsible for the alleged noise nuisance or any other query regarding this matter, please contact me and I will be happy to discuss the issue with you. Thank you in anticipation of your co-operation with this matter.
