The Council of the London Borough of Barnet, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order: -

Commencement and citation

1. This Order may be cited as The Barnet (Bus Lanes) (No.1) (Amendment No. 1) Traffic Order 2009 and shall come into operation on 16th November 2009

Interpretation

2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The Barnet (Bus Lanes) (No.1) Traffic Order 2006(b) shall have effect as though for the Schedule 1 to that Order there was substituted the Schedule to this Order.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

As part of a Congestion Reduction Scheme on the A5, various traffic engineering measures have been identified to improve traffic flow and road safety.

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The general effect of the Bus Lane Order will be to introduce new lengths and remove lengths of bus lanes on the north-east side of the A5 (except where specified) as follows:

- The bus lane on High Street/Burnt Oak Broadway, Edgware between its junctions with Station Road and Deansbrook Road will be reduced in length.
- The bus lane on Burnt Oak Broadway, Edgware, between its junctions with North Road and Watling Avenue, will be reduced in length.
- The bus lane on The Hyde NW9 between its junctions with The Greenway and Colindeep Lane, will be reduced in length.
- The bus lane on The Hyde NW9 between its junctions with Woodfield Avenue and Rushgrove Avenue, will be reduced in length
- Additional lengths of bus lane will be provided on West Hendon Broadway NW9 between its junctions with Garrick Road and Herbert Road
- The section of bus lane on West Hendon Broadway between its junctions with Brent View Road and Park Road will be reduced in length
- The section of bus lane on Cricklewood Broadway NW2 between its junctions with Depot Approach and Cricklewood Lane will be removed
- Additional lengths of bus lane will be provided on the south-west side of West Hendon Broadway NW9 between its junctions with Cool Oak Lane and the southernmost arm of Perryfield Way
- The bus lane on the south-west side of West Hendon Broadway NW9 between its junctions with both arms of Perryfield Way will be reduced in length

The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Order will be to provide waiting and loading restrictions, in order to provide protection to junctions, and to improve traffic flow, as follows:

At any time waiting restrictions will be provided around the junctions of: The Hyde and Sheaveshill Avenue NW9 (by upgrading existing waiting restrictions); The Hyde and Woodfield Avenue NW9, The Hyde and Hillfield Avenue NW9 (by upgrading existing waiting restrictions); The Hyde and Hyde Estate Road NW9 (southern side of the junction - by upgrading existing waiting restrictions); West Hendon Broadway and Herbert Road NW9 (by upgrading existing waiting restrictions); West Hendon Broadway and Perryfield Way (northern side of the northernmost arm – by upgrading existing waiting restrictions); Cricklewood Broadway and Depot Approach NW2 (by upgrading existing waiting restrictions); Cricklewood Broadway and Cricklewood Lane NW2 (by upgrading existing waiting restrictions)

At any time waiting restrictions will be provided on certain lengths of The Hyde NW9 (outside Sheaveshill Court).

At any time loading restrictions will be provided around the junction of Cricklewood Broadway and Cricklewood Lane NW2 (by upgrading existing loading restrictions)

The general effect of the Prescribed Route Orders will be to prohibit north-westbound motorists traveling on West Hendon Broadway NW9 from performing 'uturn' movements around a central island opposite No. 142 West Hendon Broadway.

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport)

This Order introduces new and removes existing lengths of bus lanes in the London Borough of Barnet.
