

FOI response CPNs, PSPOs, Income and smoking/vaping policy (ref: 6201888)

1. Please state the number of Community Protection Notices (CPNs) issued in the year November 2018-October 2019. Please provide the text or subject matter of these CPNs.

Case 1:

The land, of which you are the registered owner of, Freehold Land, [REDACTED], HA8 [REDACTED] where large amounts of waste has been deposited on by the travellers during their encampment. Causing the area to become to a health risk.

After receiving a Community Protection Warning Notice from the London Borough of Barnet, you have failed to Clear the land, of which you are the registered owner of, Freehold Land, [REDACTED] HA8 [REDACTED] of all the waste deposited by the travellers during their encampment and cleanse the area of all waste. This behaviour may or is likely to have a detrimental effect on other residents within the community.

The waste is only to be transported by a licenced carrier and disposal of waste company and you are to supply this office all the receipts from the same.

In order to address your conduct you are required to:

2. Clear the land, of which you are the registered owner of, Freehold Land, [REDACTED] HA8 [REDACTED] of all the waste deposited by the travellers during their encampment and cleanse the area of all waste. The waste is only to be transported by a licenced carrier and disposal of waste company and you are to supply this office all the receipts from the same.

Case 2:

1. You are not to act in an anti-social manner, that is to say, a manner that causes or is likely to cause harassment, alarm or distress to one or more persons not of the same household within the London Borough of Barnet, nor are you to incite, encourage or solicit any other person to do so.

2. You are not to consume alcohol in any public place within the London Borough of Barnet, other than a licensed premises

3. If using methods of public transport i.e. taxi/minicab/underground you are to produce to Police or other enforcement body receipt/proof of either the outbound or inbound journey

4. You are not to obstruct pedestrian walkways or public highways for the purposes of street entertainment. This includes walkways and footbridges within the environs of Finchley Central Tube

5. You are not to touch any unattended motor vehicle without the express permission of the owner.

6. You are not to invite, or accept voluntary contributions from any member of the public.

Whilst you can buy produce from local businesses in Finchley, you are to ensure the above conditions are adhered to and met.
