Regarding data collection, it is only DCA data that is coming to us, via the 'Update CQC on the impact of Covid' online form. This is being shared with the LGA on behalf of and for passing on to local authorities. Internally I have not seen this data yet but am trying to find out when I will get it. I will keep you updated. Care homes are filling in the NHS capacity tracker. Testing – CQC's only involvement now is with a pilot in nursing homes where we are providing the technology, information and resource to assist in the trialling of testing kits being sent to care homes for testing of residents. Obviously, in many areas there are local arrangements are in place and the testing we are supporting is an option for care home providers if they are not accessing testing for residents through other routes. We only provide front end services and have no involvement in the actual testing or receive any results. I've attached a recent DHSC/PHE letter, which you may have seen.

CQC have added a box to our death notification form for providers to tick if the death is either suspected or confirmed Covid. We have also been asked by DHSC to send out a daily survey form to domiciliary care providers (see copy attached). This data is shared on a daily basis with DHSC, Local Authorities, MHCLG/Local Resilience Forums, NHSE regional leads and their teams, and CQC inspection teams to support immediate mobilisation of help for providers.

In our daily data feed we also include data from NHS England Capacity Tracker (including residential care); CQC registration data; provider notifications; provider/public feedback via our contact centre; and public/professional feedback via our Give Feedback on Care form on our website.

I'm aware that London ADASS are also asking for this information separately, although I know that is some parts of the country they have stopped and are using our data. Happy to discuss.
