Government provided a £4.132m hardship fund for Council Tax Support recipients whereby Barnet in accordance with guidance applied £150.00 to all accounts in receipt of Council tax Support. The current spend is £3,184,430.94. From the 1st October 2020 the difference between the £4.132m and total awarded will be used to supplement Barnet's Local Welfare Support Scheme and Council Tax Hardship fund.
