Comment: The A502 is an important route for emergency services. I made a freedom of information request to London Ambulance Services and had a response on 21 November 2017. I had asked how many times per week ambulances use the road and whether there are alternatives. Their Ref 2847. This is the response from Stephen Moore, Information Governance Manager.

We have checked the number of times an LAS vehicle has driven through a representative stretch of this road and found that there were about 48 per day on average over the last 12 months. Of these on average 15 were en route to an incident.

We are not able to ascertain whether this road is in the top quartile, second quartile etc of roads used by ambulances in the capital as we would have to count the LAS traffic on every A road in London and then compare this road to every other and this is not feasible.

We do not think that there is any reasonable alternative, even with heavy traffic, to the use of this road.'

The use of the venue daily from early till late as a place of worship multiple times a day has already been shown to have a material detrimental effect on the flow of traffic. Many of the congregants live on the other side of the Northern line and so despite the proximity of the venue to the tube station, tend to drive. This will cost lives daily as the emergency services are hampered.

Comment: The new application to change the Hippodrome into one of the largest Islamic Centres in Europe is really an unnecessary wish as, in the London Boroughs of Barnet and the adjoining Brent there are nine mosques within 1.7 miles of the Centre of Islamic Enlightenment, and not forgetting the Regent's Park Mosque which must be far larger that the Hippdrome and is a purpose-built building where, incidentally, parking in Regent's Park is so much easier than in Golders Green in the residents' car park zones.

Also an important fact which has to be considered is safety, and with the anticipated thousands of people attending services in the Hippodrome, adequate access must be made for emergency vehicles in the surrounding roads, and it is well-known that parking cars can be a haphazard exercise, denying residents access to their vehicles which can give rise to serious consequences. Golders Green and Hampstead Garden Suburb are also mainly well-established Christian and Jewish wards, while the Moslem community tends to occupy the Hendon, Colidale and Burnt Oak wards.

There is no real reason why this ratio should not be maintained in peace and harmony. If there is a reason for any application to change the use of the Hippodrome, it should be used for the whole community as the Arts Depot, at the north end of Barnet, with safeguards regarding parking and use, and not as a place of worship, especially when praying can take place five times a day, and subsequent disruption to the neighbours, parking and general noise can over-ride any basic living norms.

The Hippodrome has been always an opened cultural venue for the benefit of the local and wider London community. Under current ownership the building is used exclusively for the religious use of one community. There are no alternatives, no such large venues to make up for the loss of use of such venue to London and to the local communities.

Very few of the current users are residing close by. They drive in by car. After the purchase they have shown very little concern for the effect the way they drive and park their cars affect local residents, or for the opinion of the local community. Every street in Barnet has lost numerous parking spaces in the last 2-3 weeks due to the double yellow lines on each corner to stop cars parking there. It is horrific. For example, every street off Bridge Lane, ie Havanna Drive, PPA, Decoy Ave, Cranbourne Gardens, Hillside Road, Ashbourne, Ave, Halleswelle Road, Hayes Crescent, Leeside Crescent has lost at least 4 cars worth of parking on each side of the street due to the double yellow lines.

We will have no access to North Circular Road which is already jammed packed every day and also have school runs, and to local shops and local health centres, which is needed every day of the week. Ambulances won't be able to get through to get A&E department of Royal Free, Whittington, to UCH, to Edgware, to Barnet Hospital etc. Hatzolah will not have immediate access to save lives and need help to get to critically ill patients within minutes and will now take at least 20- 30 minutes and G-D forbid, lives will be lost!

It will a very tragic error to allow this mosque to be built with 3,200 people filling the mosque 5 x a day. There are not enough busses NOW and too many people waiting in streets in all kinds of

The applicants' original intent was to use the Hippodrome for Mosque-like activities. This, was rejected by the Council. That 'rejection' has caused the consequent application to be expediently massaged, for presentational purposes, whilstretaining the core intent. The applicants have, seemingly, experienced a Damascus conversion, on the 'discovering' of non-religious activity connected 'needs' by residents in the locality. They present such 'needed' variety in three full pages to itemise. The Bard would have suitably commented, as he perceptively did so, in Hamlet Act III Scene II. No doubt the applicants, in support of their late conversion to that 'need', caused a survey to be made of the locality's needs. It would have been in support of the application to record the result of any such survey. Accordingly, the absence of the result of the survey, is significant. Having said the foregoing, the 'need' for which the applicants are minded cater is non-existent in this locality. A cursory view evidences that, persons of the Muslim persuasion are virtually non-existent in the locality. I doubt if they are even represented in the Council's Chambers.

In view of the foregoing, it is reasonable to envisage that the bulk of persons to whom the proposed centre is calculated to cater, would come from the reservoirs of such persons,

residing in the Western neighbourhoods, like Hayes & Harlington and Newham through Walthamstow to Finsbury Park, all several miles distant. In this respect, there are virtually non-existent East/West public transport facilities. Accordingly, the mass of persons calculated to use the proposed Centre would come from well outside the locality by private vehicular means, thereby swamping the already traffic intensive Central Golders Green locality, where parkingfacilities are already, over saturated, thereby causing increased inconvenience to local residents.

The applicants, implicitly, purports to have identified a need in the indigenous population to view combative English Football (which need is already well catered for, in convivial pub and restaurant surroundings, for those so inclined) and to engage in martial arts. No such need, currently obtains in this locality. The import of persons possessing any such 'needs' and, then, be obliged to cater for it is irrational. The bottom line is that a 'need' should evolve naturally and not be imported 'en-masse' to the locality's detriment, which would be the result of the import of persons, whose needs are to be catered for by an establishment housing up to 3,000 persons.

The Hippodrome was established for non-sectarian concerts, meetings and such activities. It so should remain.





I am writing in connection with the above application and wish to register my objection for the following reasons:

1. **CONGESTION:** The area surrounding the building which is the subject of the planning application has always suffered with traffic congestion and a shortage of parking. When these premises were originally acquired by the applicants there was an unacceptable increase in the level of traffic congestion which caused chaos in the surrounding streets. This building can accommodate 3000 people which suggests a significant challenge to an area which already suffers with congestion.

- 2. **PARKING:** the immediate area that surrounds the Hippodrome already suffers with limited parking and a further influx of motor vehicles will cause considerable traffic disruption. It is the case that parking has been a significant issue since the Hippodrome was acquired by the current owners. There have been several reports of "civil disobedience", rudeness, threatening behaviour and a total lack of consideration for the local residents. As mentioned above a facility thataccommodates 3000 people will make what is already a very difficult parkingsituation impossible.
- 3. **DECEIPT:** when this property was originally purchased the owners submitted an application for acultural centre open to all and specifically not a Mosque. It is my understanding that the application was granted for use as a cultural and educational facility on the understanding that it would not become a Mosque. There is anecdotal evidence to suggest that the planning application was submitted with the intention of establishing the cultural facility and then re-apply later for additional use including a Mosque, a consent through the back door.
- 4. **STRATEGY:** it is well documented that it is common practice to purchase a building, apply for planning permission for a cultural centre (with assurances that it would be open to all commers) knowing that permission for a Mosque would be rejected. Having established a presence in the building, an application for additional permissions including a Mosque is submitted. Please see Cordoba Project, Trocadero, Bradford, New York Ground Zero, and countless others.
- 5. **FACILITY:** I have read in the press that the current owners have stated that their community is limited to 150 people. The number of people attending the building initially was significantly more than 150 people which leads me to question that statement as the building is capable of housing 3000 people. This area does not have a large Muslim community and therefore cannot see the need for such a large prayer facility which will undoubtedly import significant levels of traffic.
- 6. **BUILDING:** the building itself is an iconic grade 2 listed building created specifically as an entertainment venue. Changing the use to a Mosque would make a mockery of the Listing system.
- 7. **MOSQUE:** when this building was purchased by the current owners, planning was sought for a cultural centre open to everyone. The evidence is that it was not open toeveryone and that some ethnic minorities were prevented from access to the facility. As a Mosque, access would be even less available.

It is the case that once a piece of land is consecrated as a Mosque it can never revert back to common use. Given the iconic nature of the building, it's grade 2 listing and the way in which it is likely to be altered, permission for aMosque is entirely inappropriate.

8. **CALL to PRAYER:** it has been reported that there are five Calls to Prayer each day commencing at sunrise, which can be as early as 5 in the

morning, and ending late at night, sometimes approaching midnight. As this is not a Muslim area the Calls to Prayer could be invasive to the local residents and disturb their right to peaceful enjoyment of their property.

9. **PRETEXT:** at outset these premises were a hive of activity and the negative issues of parking and congestion were plain for all to see. More recently and coinciding with the application for permission to establish a Mosque, the activity has died down, and there is a body of thought which suggests that this has been done intentionally in order to "allay fears" of a large influx of worshippers. As mentioned above, a 3000 seat facility will obviously attract at least the same amount of people, together with the traffic, congestion and parking issues that were witnessed prior to the recent reduction in use.

I am writing to you to voice my objection to the planning application mentioned above changing the use to a Mosque which I believe to be totally inappropriate for the reasons stated above.





I am a local resident of the hippodrome and strongly object to the building being granted permission for use as a place of worship.

As a very local and long-term stakeholder with a young and growing family, I would love to see this building be put to a use that would benefit the local and wider Golders Green community and without any religious affiliation, such as the Arts Depot in Finchley, Hampstead Community Centre, or the Sheriff Centre in West Hampstead (whilst housed in a church building, it is a post office, coffee shop/cafe, soft play and gift shop).

A multi-use public space could service the needs of the many local young families as well as the sizeable elderly population and act as a place to unite the community, rather than alienate anyone not of the faith that the building belongs to. It could become a destination for local residents to relish and be proud of and minimise the need for travel out of the area.

Golders Green lacks character and there are no appealing public spaces to sit or relax in. The formerly delightful library has been annexed and many cafes and shops have closed. The hippodrome is one of the only historical buildings in the area and has such potential to be an accessible, multi-use public space in the heart of the town centre.

Allowing this building to be used as a place of worship would **further segregate an already fragmented community**. 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



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

I have looked on the Council website for the NEW planning application for the Golders Green Hippodrome but have been unable to find a **new** application, only the existing application submitted in July 2020. It would further appear that no comments have been made with regard to this application, whereas when I looked yesterday there was a comment. I consider it misleading of you not to record that comments have been made, but have for some reason been removed. The comment I read was quite innocuous. It looks as though this is an historic planning application not one which the Council is preparing to reconsider. I would like to object on the grounds that this is an inappropriate site for a building which aims to attract large numbers of visitors. The off road parking space is small and tight. When there are several vehicles attempting to enter others are queuing up in the street outside obstructing the traffic and in particular local buses. The site of the Hippodrome is right next to the edge of the Golders Green Town Centre for which there are Development proposals. These appear to have been overlooked or ignored by the Applicant. These I thought aimed to reduce traffic in the area and make it more "people friendly". There is no indication of how the re-developed Hippodrome will fit in with this scheme. What are the Council's views on this.

The proposals for the Town Centre scheme envisage the removal of the roundabout on the Finchley Road/North End Road junction and replacing it with cross roads. This will make the congestion at that

junction even worse that it is now. At peak times there is often congestion there with vehicles having to wait for several changes of the lights before being able to move and other vehicles backing up in North End Road.

The residents of North End Road have to pay to park in their street. When events are held which finish after the main public transport services have stopped for the night, visitors to the Hippodrome will have taken parking spaces and left nowhere for residents returning after an evening out to park.

Why does the Applicant think that re-submitting an Application which I thought had already been refused by the Council will be successful this time? Has there been some change in the conditions covering the Application which have not been mentioned on the Council website?

There be terrible traffic to other neighbours and it will be hard to get to RFH for appointments and clinics and no parking anywhere in Barnet/ Hampstead / Hampstead Garden Suburb, Highgate and Access to Whittington Hospital.

Every street in Barnet has lost numerous parking spaces in the last 2-3 weeks due to the double yellow lines on each corner to stop cars parking there. It is horrific. For example, every street off Bridge Lane, ie Havanna Drive, PPA, Decoy Ave, Cranbourne Gardens, Hillside Road, Ashbourne, Ave, Halleswelle Road, Hayes Crescent, Leeside Crescent has lost at least 4 cars worth of parking on each side of the street due to the double yellow lines.

The Golders Green Hippodrome is a beloved listed building that has been used extensively by the community for many years. It is an important forum for conferences, plays, and dance. This plan is for a mosque twice the size of Finsbury Park and comparable in size to Regents Park, the principal mosque in London. This is incompatible with the historic use and character of the building. The wider community will not be able to make use of our beautiful amenity.

Traffic is already a problem around Golders Green station. A 3000 seat mosque with an additional standing room will make a bad situation much worse, especially given the vast majority of users will not be local. This will be a particular problem over periods like Ramadan when worshippers can be coming out of the mosque well after midnight. It is noteworthy as well that the mosque has already exceeded their opening hours of 23:30 and caused extensive disturbance to residents. The restrictions on opening hours have proved impossible to enforce in the short time they have been there.

Adding what the applicants intend to be the largest centre of Islamic worship in Europe to the Golders Green area will certainly not help with the problem of pollution. Twice the legal limit for NO2 has already been detected in the area and more cars means even more pollution.



I am opposed to the planned conversion of the Hippodrome building to a mosque, primarily for the detrimental effect it is sure to have on traffic congestion in the vicinity.

My wife and I are Jewish by descent, but we are not religious. I have been able to ascertain the character of the Moslem group behind the project and I am satisfied that they are non-violent and have no serious animosity towards Jews, religious or otherwise. There is no reason to suppose that they will preach hatred, or the expulsion of Jews from the land of Israel - were this not so, I would object much more strongly to their use of a building in any part of London, and especially a site surrounded by a predominantly Jewish population..

My objection is thus threefold.

Firstly, and most important, the proposed mosque would of necessity bring most worshippers to this already very busy road junction either by car or by buses or coaches. Very few of the anticipated members will live in walking distance; and of those, many will choose not to walk, understandably. The congestion would be insufferable.

Secondly, although the Moslem leaders of the project are certainly not anti-Jewish, it is likely that the influx of a demonstrably Moslem event will give rise to the stirring of anti-Jewish demonstrations and inflammatory speeches by the Islamists, who are aready active in other parts of London. The moderates have no power to prevent this.

Thirdly, the Hippodrome is an important part of the heritage of Golders Green, and an attractive building of some historic importance. There are many uses which could be made of it which would preserve its architectural merit and would serve to strengthen feelings of communality amongst the many and varied racial, ethnic and religious goups in the borough. It would be ideal if it could become a home for the celebration of the performance arts such as live theatre, musical concerts, exhibitions of dance and the like. Unlike the mosque proposal, this would reflect the multicultural nature of the population, but in such a way as not to bring crowds of visitors by cars and coaches at particular times of prayer.

We have been aware for some time about the intention to convert this building into one of the biggest mosques in Europe and we are writing to you to register our deepest concerns about the damage that this will do to the whole area and in particular to our business.

Clowns Nursery is located further up North End Road and it is next door to Hillside Doctor Surgery which in turn is next door to King Alfred School and directly across the road to St. Anthony School for Girls. As you will appreciate there is a long running history of parking issues in this particular area and it has been difficult, even more so since the new school opened across the road a few years ago. All of these four businesses suffer enormously at certain times of the day when parking is in heavy demand and extremely difficult.

In the summer months this sometimes intolerable situation is exacerbated by visitors to Golders Hill Park and quite frankly far too many people are vying for too few parking spaces.

The mosque will have an enormous number of visitors at several times in the day starting early in the morning and from what we can see there are very few on site parking facilities, the few they do have will no doubt be taken up by management of that building so congregants will need to find alternative parking

As it stands Golders Green does not exactly cater well for parking and in my opinion the High Street in particular suffered a near catastrophe many years ago when Brent Cross opened. Many Golders Green businesses did not survive and the properties ended up being filled with charity shops. Thankfully in recent years and with a good economy this area has managed to reestablish itself as a trading area despite the lack of parking spaces.


Taking it from the perspective of our business I can see a potential disaster let the other teaching institutions around us.

Visitors to the mosque will find it difficult to park in that area and all they will do is simply go to the streets around the area of the mosque us and more likely to the areas that are around the Hampstead Heath Extension and more importantly to the top end of North End Road where we are situated. This will result in hardly any occasions whereby our visiting parents will have the facility to drop off the children and collect them.

Our objection in this letter is purely based on the detrimental effects it will have on our business but we dread to think of the effect it will have on all the shops and other businesses in the vicinity of the mosque. With the after effects of the Coronavirus pandemic, I dread to think how many businesses will be under pressure to survive. As online trading continues to grow, it will become a ghost town with potential new occupiers discouraged by the almost impossible parking restrictions and facilities especially if this substantial mosque be allowed permission to occupy this property.

I therefore firmly object to the application made above. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any question.



I am writing to you regarding the proposals to change the usage of the Hippodrome and am basing my comments on reflections after clarifications I culled from my email exchange with Mr Duffin.

I feel very strongly that both the internal and external structure of this historic building should be maintained. In principle there seems no reason why religious worship within the current structure should be limited to any one religion. However I have always identified a mosque as a structure with different architectural features and I am therefore afraid that if a change of usage to a mosque is granted, this will be followed by a request to change aspects of the structure.

My second concern is that whereas there are a multitude of churches within the area, there are few mosques. Therefore many more cars and other vehicles will come to the site causing major parking and congestion problems.

A mosque as a religious centre is also an important amenity and may merits Council support, I feel very strongly that careful consideration should be given to the location of such a building and the logistical implications. Parking, traffic, noise, safety and other environmental issues convince me that this is not the right location. particularly for a building whose size is clearly not simply to fulfil local needs.

Such a large centre may attract an audience which could possibly cause local residents to feel, rightly or wrongly, threatened. If the Council judges it beneficial to have such a large religious centre in its midst, I am sure a more suitable site can be found.

I hope you will give these concerns careful consideration and find an alternative way to meet the reasonable requirements of the local Muslim population.





That corner is already congested with cars and particularly buses. Please no more traffic.









As someone who lives locally and is often in Golders Green for food shopping and, in normal circumstances, to visit friends and family, I wish to object most strongly to this application.

I do recall that when the building was acquired, the purchaser confirmed and made very clear that the building was to be used solely as a cultural centre and not as a place of worship.

As it is now, there is huge disruption in the local area especially on a Friday - to be quite frank, I always suspected the building was being used as a place of worship contrary to the original remit, I have seen what happens there on a Friday.

The Golders Green Hippodrome, as you will recall, was the home of the BBC Orchestra and the beautiful building has always been considered iconic to the Golders Green area.

For this kind of proposed further change of use is really very disappointing.

Golders Green is most definitely not the place for a mosque. It is somewhere that has many cafes, food shops, retail - and once lockdown is lifted it will no doubt return to its buzzy atmosphere. In other words, a western culture one expects in an area such as Golders Green, which is also, it must be remembered, the transport terminus for buses, National Coaches and the Northern Line.

This proposal will mean that thousands more will flood into the area not only causing chaos at the already busy public transport terminus for buses, coaches and the Tube, but the road traffic will be affected negatively amd the environment will suffer greatly.

I have travelled extensively and you will not see a mosque in the centre of any similar area in the western world.

In any case, there are enough mosques already elsewhere around London. If this application is granted it will ruin the atmosphere of Golders Green and make it a no-go environment and totally discourage the existing local community.

It will just be the beginning of the change in culture and downgrade of the area - as seen in so many other places in London and its suburbs where mosques have already been built.

And as a woman I would fear for myself walking around. It is already bad enough in somewhere such as the Edgware Road - where to walk along, as a Western woman, is very intimidating, especially in the early evenings; by 9pm it is completely male dominated.

This application is a horrifying prospect and a backward step for Golders Green.



The building and the surrounding road system have been designed 100 years ago for a different function. Only massive changes such as demolition of a number of nearby buildings and a new road system can answer current requirements of traffic and parking for the use of a 3000 seats auditorium. The promise that only over 600 people will use a building 5 times bigger is not credible. Why would anyone buy a building 5 times bigger if not intending to use it fully? In fact the video published within days of the purchase stated clearly the intention to use it to its full capacity. That of course makes sense and is credible.

The Hippodrome has been always an opened cultural venue for the benefit of the local and wider London community. Under current ownership the building is used exclusively for the religious use of one community. There are no alternatives, no such large venues to make up for the loss of use of such venue to London and to the local communities.

Very few of the current users are residing close by. They drive in by car. After the purchase they have shown very little concern for the effect the way they drive and park their cars affect local residents, or for the opinion of the local community. The powerful opposition to their initial application is the proof of that.

The current planning appeal on behalf of the local community is still pending. Instead of respecting the pending legal process the new owners are now acting aggressively and have lodged a second application. How much trust and positive feelings can such behavior create between the newcomers and the local community? Not very much, and it did not.

I believe the Councillors had plenty of time to find out and know very well by now which is the true will of the local community in this matter. I therefore trust that this second aggressive application will not be taken forward by the council and the currently pending planning appeal is respected and carried out according to the letter of the law.

As a resident of Golders Green I would like to express my objection to the proposed application in the strongest terms possible. Golders Green Town Centre where the Hippodrome is located is an area which offers a wide range of cherished amenities, including many essential services, both to the local community and beyond. Due to already high congestion and limited parking it is sadly already difficult to have full access to these amenities. The proposed conversion of the Hippodrome to a giant mosque would hugely increase congestion in the area and further reduce available parking, making it even more difficult for us local residents to access these shops and amenities which we hold so dearly to ourselves.
