


Dear Mr Duffin,

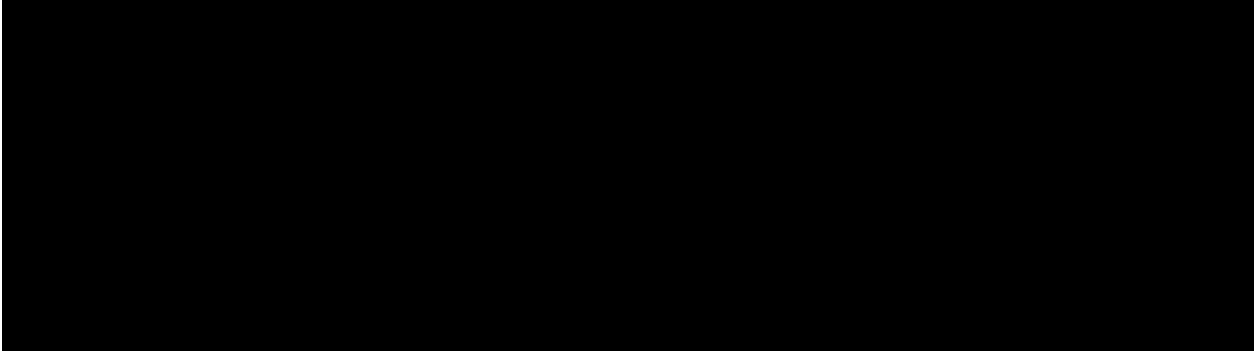



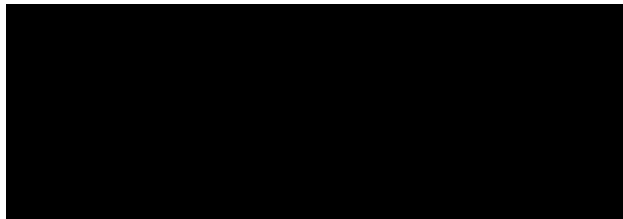

A bus trip from the top of Golders Green Road (on corner with Finchley Road) used to take 8 to 10 minutes to cross the North Circular road into Hendon - this same trip now takes over 15 minutes.
