We have processed this request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

## **Response**

I can confirm that London Borough of Barnet holds the information you requested. However, we believe that the exemptions detailed below apply to some of this information and this is withheld. Please see the Refusal Notice below.

These are inspected during the Highways cyclical inspection regime, and this is conducted twice a year.

## **S40(2)**

We have withheld the costings by virtue of section 40 (2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), as disclosure of this information to the public generally, in the Council's view, would not be consistent with the data protection principle found in Article 5.1(a) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) lawfully, transparently and fairly. We have considered whether disclosure is lawful and fair and whilst it may be lawful under Article 6.1(f) GDPR (legitimate interests) it would not be fair to the individuals concerned who would not expect this information to be disclosed as part of such a request
