Sui Generis is a Planning designation.

Under the <u>Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987</u> several classes of use are defined for which planning permission needs to be obtained. If a use is not mentioned in the use classes order they are know as a Sui Generis use. A Sui Generis use still requires planning permission but is likely to be more specific than the generallyy more broad definitions contained in specific use classes.
