- * How many of the existing zoological gardens in your council, which have a permit/license, keep/have kept tigers (Panthera tigris) (number of zoological gardens),
- * How many tigers (Panthera tigris) are kept in zoos with a permit/license (number of tigers),
- * How many rescue centers are there in your council for tigers (Panthera tigris),
- * How many tigers (Panthera tigris) in your council have lived/live in rescue centers,
- * Is there a notification duty to centrally report the number of deceased captive tigers (Panthera tigris),
- * If so, how many tigers (Panthera tigris) have died in your council in the last five years,
- * Following information of records kept by zoos, sanctuaries and other owners, how many tigers (Panthera tigris) have died in the last five years.
