Young people's substance misuse support: The total value of the current contract is £590,516

Young People's Substance Misuse Service contract expiry date is 31st March 2020

Re-procurement has already happened. The Services were put out to Tender on 19th August 2019. Following the procurement process, it was recommended the Contract is awarded to Change Grow Live (CGL). The Contract term for the service is for three (3) years with the option to extend for a further two (2) years. The new service is one contract including young people services ; Barnet Integrated Substance Misuse Prevention, Treatment and Recovery Service for Young People and Adults

7th January 2020 will be the first implementation and mobilisation meeting with the new provider.
