Response

I can confirm that London Borough of Barnet holds the information you requested.

However, we believe that the exemptions detailed below apply to all the information you requested and so we are withholding that information. Please see the Refusal Notice below.

I would appreciate this information in a computer readable format as I use assistive technology so any format besides a scanned PDF is preferable please.

This area is currently under review and the results will be published within the next six months. Therefore we consider that the qualified exemption set out in Section 22 subsection 2 (Information intended for future publication) applies to the information requested. Therefore, we have decided to withhold the information.

In applying this exemption, we have had to balance the public interest in withholding the information against the interest in favour of disclosure.

Factors in favour of disclosure

- The council's commitment to transparency
- Legitimate public interest in understanding how the council ensures that services are accessible.

Factors in favour of withholding

• The information being requested is currently being reviewed and analysed and prepared for publication.

In all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.
