Also if possible give the date of when and if any resurfacing works been carried out by yourselves.

Please also note this information is not publicly available to us nor is it easily accessible as we are based in Bradford, West Yorkshire.

We therefore feel this request is in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (section 21) and The Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (Reg 6(1)).
