In all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.

Factors in favour of disclosure

- Transparency and legitimate public interest in measures being taken to protect safety of the public

Factors in favour of withholding

- To dedicate efforts on advancing publication may undermine current safeguarding processes and may ultimately cause us to duplicate efforts which would not be the most efficient use of current resources
- There is greater public importance for the release of accurate and consistent messaging to best protect those vulnerable and at risk.

In all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.
