I have recently noticed that controlled parking zones have been set up outside the Pure Gym on East End Road N2 2TA East Finchley. Could you inform me to why? as I am now worried that these may be extended further down to where our shop is in N2 OSP

without the courtesy of any consultation.

We have processed this request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

## Response

The council holds the information requested and the answers to your questions are below

I have recently noticed that controlled parking zones have been set up outside the Pure Gym on East End Road N2 2TA East Finchley. Could you inform me to why? as I am now worried

that these may be extended further down to where our shop is in N2 OSP without the courtesy of any consultation.

There has been no CPZ introduced in the vicinity of PureGym, East End Road – rather a scheme, incorporating limited parking bays, lengths of yellow lines, and a one-way system has been introduced in the vicinity of St Theresa's school in order to improve road safety in the vicinity of the school.

There are no current plans to introduce restrictions in the vicinity of N2 0SP.
