Thank you for your request received on 16 December 2020, for the following information:

I am looking to find out the locations of Pedestrian 'Centre Island' crossings in Barnet Borough Council. Please can you provide me with the following information:

- 1) A list of all the pedestrian crossings marked with a white centre island globe beacon within Barnet Borough Council boundaries.
- 2) Information on how many 'White centre island globe beacons' on each crossing point.
- 3) The above would ideally include the use of the Geo-coordinate system information of each site, but also the street name and location.

The information will be used to provide a complete map of the District to aid in the navigation of Barnet Borough Council for pedestrians.

We have processed this request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

#### Response

The council holds the information requested and the answers to your questions are below

I am looking to find out the locations of Pedestrian 'Centre Island' crossings in Barnet Borough Council. Please can you provide me with the following information:

1) A list of all the pedestrian crossings marked with a white centre island globe beacon within Barnet Borough Council boundaries.

Please see the attached file, this includes both the asset types" SB - Central Island Column" (See Picture 1) and "SB - Belisha Beacon" (See Picture 2). We treat all assets individually so you cannot determine from the individual asset information if the centre Island column is part of a Zebra crossing which also has Belisha Beacon assets in the vicinity. You also have the hybrid type assets which have both a centre island globe and a belisha beacon globe attached to the same structure (see Picture 3).

# 2) Information on how many 'White centre island globe beacons' on each crossing point.

A lantern count for the following lantern types, PH1 – Beacon Centre Island, PH1 – Beacon Globe and ZB1 Beacon is included for each asset. By filtering on these you can establish which individual assets have both types attached to them.

## 3) The above would ideally include the use of the Geo-coordinate system information of each site, but also the street name and location.

The road name, secondary location and easitng/northing co-ordinates of the individual assets have been included.
