- \* Your average bin collection rates (success as a percentage)
- \* How often on bins are collected
- \* The average size (in litres) of your bins
- \* How much (in tonnes) your council recycled in the last full year you have information for
- \* What percentage of refuse collected by your local authority is recycled (i.e. does not go to landfill)

***\* Your average bin collection rates (success as a percentage)***

Response - The success rate is currently 99.94%

***\* How often on bins are collected***

Response - Weekly for general waste and recycling, fortnightly for residents that have signed up for the chargeable garden waste service

***\* The average size (in litres) of your bins***

Response - 240 litre

***\* How much (in tonnes) your council recycled in the last full year you have information for***

Response - Below figures are from 01-01-2020 to 31-12-2020

Commingle – 29,023.5 tonnes

Green garden waste – 10,821 tonnes

***\* What percentage of refuse collected by your local authority is recycled (i.e. does not go to landfill)***

Response - The percentage of household waste recycled, composted or reused was 32% in 2019/20. The remainder was sent for disposal, this is primarily through energy from waste, with a small proportion sent to landfill.
