Response - 5 a mix of Peugeot and Nissan Vans

#### 3. Whether you have an established EV network and who runs this

Response - Hire vehicles from various outlets

# 4. Information on your public EV charging operation and if anybody operates this on your behalf

Response - We currently have 72 CityEV lamp charge points across the borough, the locations of which can be found on our website. We will shortly be expanding our network of lamp column charge points and plan to rollout additional Siemens charge points throughout 2021.

Furthermore, we have a network PodPoint freestanding charge points and community charging hubs located in town centre car parks across Barnet. This is in addition to ChargeMaster charging facilities at both New Barnet and Copthall Leisure Centre.

We will shortly be installing our first rapid charge points which will allow an EV to 80% charge within half an hour.
