I can confirm that London Borough of Barnet holds the information you requested.

However, we believe that the exceptions detailed below apply to all the information you requested and so we are withholding that information. Please see the Refusal Notice below.

You will need to include the reference number(s) and full postal address of the required planning application(s) in your request.

Payment can be made by cheque or credit/debit card.

It may take up to 10 working days for files to be retrieved from the archives. The Planning Receptionist will contact you once the file has been retrieved. The file will be held in the office for 5 working days. Copies of documentation within the file can be made at a further photocopying fee.

If you require copies of the document on your viewing there is a charge of £1.00 per paper for copies of A4 and £1.50 per paper for A3 copies

Please note that we do not accept cash payments.
