Refusal Notice Personal data Section 40(2) identifying individuals through statistical tables (fewer than 5)

The information you require is below, but some information has been redacted in the table. This is because in some instances, owing to the low numbers of individuals involved (fewer than 5) disclosing this data may make it possible for individuals to be identified. This information is therefore exempt by virtue of section 40 (2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), as disclosure of this information to the public generally, in the Council's view, would not be consistent with data protection principles in Article 5 of the General Data Protection Regulations. This is an absolute exemption and the public interest test does not apply.

Refusal Notice - exceeds cost limit Section 12

We are refusing your request under section 12 because we estimate that compliance with your request will exceed the "appropriate limit" under section 12. The appropriate limit is £450 which is equivalent to 18 hours at £25 per hour. The per hour figure is set by Regulations rather than actual salary paid to any officers handling requests. The appropriate limit includes the time it will take the council to discover if it holds the information requested, to locate it, extract it and collate it as well as putting it into any particular format requested by the requester.

We are unable to provide this information within the statutory 18-hour limit because we do not collect this data in a retrievable format. To obtain this information we need to read each Section 47 enquiry to ascertain if this enquiry was held in respect of a child placed at one of the above establishments

For the last 3 years approximately 2490 Section 47 enquiries have been conducted.

It would take at least 5 minutes to review each case to find out if the Section 47 enquiries was held in respect of a child placed at one of the above establishments.

 $2490 \times 5 = 207 \text{ hours}$

We must therefore refuse your request, please see Refusal notice (Section 12) below.
