Thank you for your request received on 2 July 2021, for the following information:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, we request the following information and documentation:

- 1. Copies of your tree policies within the period January 2009 and 21 September 2019 or where to locate said policies if readily accessible in electronic format;
- 2. A copy of your tree maintenance works carried out to the trees under your ownership and control, located at the rear to the Dollis Parade no. 64/66/76/78 between January 2009 and 21 September 2019, pertaining to but not restricted to recommended works, extent of works completed and inspections;
- 3. A copy of your risk analysis in respect of the relevant vegetation, between January 2009 and 21 September 2019, to include any maintenance regimes, if any, also carried out within this period;
- 4. Details of the information retained by and/or accessible to you in respect of the soil types in:
- 5. The number of tree related claims including but not limited to any fallen tree claims that have been brought against you within the N20 8 postcode area and Dollis Parade between January 2009 and 21 September 2019. For each claim please confirm:
- 5.1 Location of the tree (by house number)
- 5.2 Species of the implicated tree
- 5.3 The date of the claim

Please note that we do not require any personal information to be provided to us such as names etc. You may wish to redact any personal information when providing responses to the above queries.

We have processed this request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

## Response

I am writing to inform you that we have searched our records and although we hold some of the information requested, some is not held by London Borough of Barnet because:

A copy of your risk analysis in respect of the relevant vegetation, between January 2009 and 21 September 2019, to include any maintenance regimes, if any, also carried out within this period. This is not available.

We have provided answers to your request below showing where we do not hold the information requested.

Inspected July 2014, no work recommended

Inspected October 2019, works carried out May 2020 (Cut back over property side)

T156- Hornbeam. Inspected October 2019, works carried out in May 2020 (crown lift)

T154 - Hornbeam. Inspected October 2019. No work recommended

T158- Oak. Inspected August 2013, works carried out October 2013 (up to 30% crown reduction, Cut back to balance and lift 4m over access road)

We did not hold any specific risk data for this location.
