The A1000 Traffic scheme is causing massive problems. I was informed in a letter that the Council was looking to make improvements. More recently I have read that a unit in the Council is investigating this. Please inform me of what progress has been made, and what is the name and contact details of this unit. I wish to present evidence, in the form of hundreds of emails from the Fortis Green Nextdoor online group, indicating the many problems that the scheme has created.

We have processed this request under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

## Response

The council holds the information requested and it is below.

The council is currently undertaking traffic monitoring along the A1000 and reviewing the possibility of addition loading bay on the side roads and implement them where possible.
