The above charges were adopted at Environment Committee on 8 November 2016, and the minutes of that meeting note that the Commissioning Director Environment was requested to consider the impact of 7 seater (larger) vehicles within the charging structure. When implemented, the above charges included a discount for vehicles with seven seats or more which reduced of a top-band permit to the middle band price

A discount for vehicles with seven seats or more is applicable which reduces the price of a top-band permit to the middle band price.
