Thank you for your request received on 23 August 2021, for the following information:

I would be grateful if you could please provide the following information via email under the Freedom of Information Act:

- 1. How many apprenticeships were started in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021 to date in your authority area? Please give data separately broken down by academic year.
- 2. Please provide number of apprenticeships started (as per Question 1) in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021 to date in your authority area broken down by age.
- 3. Please provide a breakdown of apprenticeships started (as per Question 1) in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021 to date in your authority area broken down by gender.
- 4. Please provide a breakdown of apprenticeships started (as per Question 1) in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021 to date in your authority area broken down by industry of the apprenticeships.

Please prioritise your response to the questions in the order asked i.e. if time constraints do not allow for all questions to be answered, please answer Q1 first.

We have processed this request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

# Response

I can confirm that London Borough of Barnet holds the information you requested. However, we are withholding some of that information since we consider that the following exemptions apply to it as outlined below.

# **Refusal Notice**

We are refusing parts of your request as outlined above under section 12 because we estimate that compliance with your request will exceed the "appropriate limit" under section 12. The appropriate limit is £450 which is equivalent to 18 hours at £25 per hour. The per hour figure is set by Regulations rather than actual salary paid to any officers handling requests. The appropriate limit includes the time it will take the council to discover if it holds the information requested, to locate it, extract it and collate it as well as putting it into any particular format requested by the requester.

We have calculated that it will take approximately 23 hours to comply with your request. Our calculation is as follows:

There are 349 apprentice files and we estimate it would take a minimum of 4 minutes to extract and collate the requested information from each file which would take over 23 hours to complete.

The council is looking to publish this data from 2020/21 onward starting at the end of this year.
