Response

The council holds the information requested and the answers to your questions are below

1. Which agency/organisation/individual provides counselling/therapeutic support to birth parents following adoption?

Through Adopt London North (RAA) there is provision for independent specialist birth parent counselling and a support group, contracted to PAC-UK currently.

2. What is the total amount of government funding provided to the Local authority adoption team per annum?

London Borough of Barnet's contribution to the regional adoption agency Adopt London North is £592,688

3. From this total amount how much money is allocated to the provision of post adoption counselling/therapeutic support for birth parents?



The PAC-UK contract specifically managed by Adopt London North which is detailed in response to question 1 is currently worth £78,000 per annum, however this contract provides services for the whole of ALN, covering 6 boroughs of which London Borough of Barnet is one, and also provides specialist independent adoption counselling services to adopted adults and to some prospective and current adoptive parents. The contract is not divided into costed provision for different client groups, it is used flexibly between client groups according to demand and monitored by ALN. Therefore it is not possible to say what amount of money specifically is allocated to supporting only birth parents within this contract.
