S12 – Exceeds Appropriate Limit

We estimate that the cost of complying with your request would exceed the appropriate limit of \pounds 450. The appropriate limit has been specified in regulations and for the London Borough of Barnet is set at \pounds 450.

There were 1322 road closures in Barnet last year. We would have to go through each of the 1322 and measure. It would take approx 5 minutes per closure. This represents the estimated cost of one person spending 110 hours in determining whether the Council holds the information, and locating, retrieving and extracting the

information. Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act we are not obliged to comply with your request and we will not be processing your request further.

Provide advice and assistance if possible. We are unable to suggest how the request could be narrowed to bring it within 18 hours.
