Please can I see a copy of the report for this inspection please. There are clear defects in the road and I'll happily take photos however please share the report.

This issue is still on-going since 16 Jan 2021 when I first reported it. The vibrations to my property on Mays Lane (opposite St. Catherines school. Next to the junction of Underhill) is getting worse and we can now hear the pipes shaking in our house. Having been in touch with Barnet Council who passed this problem on to TFL (in 2021) who then reported it to Metroline nothing has actually been done. This is causing extreme vibrations to properties on Mays Lane specifically the properties right next to the junction. Vibrations are felt through the house when buses/large vehicles travel in both directions. This is causing us issues going to sleep and is continuing to wake us up as soon as the buses start operating. Cracks are also appearing in our property wall. We'be been in touch with Barnet Council and Highways Correspondence since June 2022 with videos, photos, and diagrams and still nothing has been done.

We have processed this request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
