Thank you for your request received on 11 February 2023, for the following information:

I'm sorry to trouble you again about this, but I don't know how to read and decipher spreadsheets.

1 - I am writing to request a copy of the expenditure statement for the year 2021 to 2022. I would like the full transactional list of all of the expenses paid by the council. I do not require the profit and loss spreadsheet. I do not want to see percentages but itemised proof in pounds ( $\pounds$ s) as to where the annual council tax is being spent.

2 - I would like to know if my council tax funds the Police Service, Ambulance Service, waste collection and Schools.

3 - If the above services are being funded I would like to know the percentages for each.

I would be very grateful for your help and assistance,

We have processed this request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

#### Response

I can confirm that London Borough of Barnet holds the information you requested.

However, we believe that the exemption detailed below applies to all of this information and this is withheld.

Please see the Refusal Notice below.

### S22 - Material intended for publication

We consider that the qualified exemption set out in Section 22 subsection 2 (Information intended for future publication) applies to the information requested. Therefore, we have decided to withhold the information.

Due to the complexity of the data you have requested this requires in depth analysis and we are unable to disclose this until publication.

In applying this exemption, we have had to balance the public interest in withholding the information against the interest in favour of disclosure.

# Factors in favour of disclosure

- Furthering the understanding, and participation in the public debate of issues
- Facilitate the accountability and transparency of public authorities for decisions taken
- Facilitate accountability and transparency in the spending of public money
- Allowing individuals to understand decisions made by public authorities which affect their lives

### Factors in favour of withholding

- Partial disclosures of information could result in inaccuracy and incompleteness of the data in question
- Organisations should be able to complete work in a timely fashion without interruption and interference from outside before being subjected to scrutiny

In all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.
