Barnet does not hold data on personal injury collisions directly but has access to records held by TfL.You can obtain data directly from TfL's public facing Road Danger reduction dashboard, which can be accessed here <a href="https://tfl.gov.uk/corporate/publications-and-reports/road-safety#on-this-page-1">https://tfl.gov.uk/corporate/publications-and-reports/road-safety#on-this-page-1</a>. Page 4 of the dashboard provides a collision map that can be filtered to collisions in the area and time period you are interested in.
