Open Door Homes is a wholly owned subsidiary of Barnet Homes which, in turn, is a wholly owned subsidiary of LB Barnet. Therefore, all the land and property that is transferred to Open Door Homes forms part of LB Barnet's legally owned assets.

Open Door Homes is LB Barnet's development arm that develops social and sheltered housing within the borough of Barnet.
