I can confirm that the council holds the information you requested. However we are withholding the information because we consider that the following exemption exemptions and exceptions apply to it.

For Q1 and Q2. Information no longer held for 2010 as Concil's retention policy is to retain this for 10 years. See Refusal Notice below.

Refusal Notice S12 - Cost limit (Exceeds Appropriate Limit)

We are refusing your request under section 12 because we estimate that compliance with your request will exceed the "appropriate limit" under section 12. The appropriate limit is £450 which is equivalent to 18 hours at £25 per hour. The per hour figure is set by Regulations rather than actual salary paid to any officers handling requests. The appropriate limit includes the time it will take the council to discover if it holds the information requested, to locate it, extract it and collate it as well as putting it into any particular format requested by the requester.

We have calculated that it will take approx. 375 hours to comply with your request.

Our calculation is as follows:

Reactive Planned and Cyclical works across the three year period is around 4,500 entries. We are unable to run a report on works carried out on an individual community centre and each entry would need to be manually checked.
